Introduction to DevOps – and how it impacts Business Analysts

Many organizations are moving to the DevOps framework, and there are a lot of job postings for DevOps developers. Why was this framework introduced and what's the appeal? How does this framework change the development and delivery cycle, and what does it mean for the organization that adopts it? DevOps organizations embrace Agile project management, and follow Continuous Delivery principles to achieve an unprecedented speed of software delivery in conjunction with increase quality.
