

1. Entry Certificate in Business Analysis™ (ECBA® - Level 1), Certificate of Competency in Business Analysis™ (CCBA® - Level 2), and Certified Business Analysis Professional™ (CBAP® - Level 3)/ Scholarship Program Applications
 - Applications are invited from all eligible business analysts (BAs) for the award of full application and examination fees related to the certification exam.
 - Applications to be submitted via email using the application form below.
2. Scholarship Availability/Application Period
 - One scholarship is awarded annually.
 - Application period is from November 1st to October 31st, based on Annual General Meeting (AGM) schedule.
3. Application Deadline
 - Scholarship application must be received by October 31st of the application submission year.
4. Eligibility
 - The applicant must be a current member of the International Institute of Business Analysis™ (IIBA®) and the Vancouver Chapter for the year in which the scholarship is applied for.
 - The applicant must not be eligible for employer funding of exam. (It is the intent of the Vancouver Chapter to support those members who may find it financially difficult to pay the application and examination fees. Please note that by making a false application for the scholarship you will potentially be taking funds from a deserving applicant who may not otherwise be able to pay the fees.)
 - The applicant must pass one of the certification exams mentioned in point #1 above (ECBA®, CCBA®, or CBAP®).
 - The applicant must have passed one of the certification exams no later than September 30th of the application submission year. (This is to facilitate the Chapter's need to review all applications and to determine the successful candidate before the AGM, which is held in November of each year. The successful applicant will be announced at that time. For those applicants writing the exam between October 1 and October 31, applications will be reviewed for the following year.)
5. Weighting Criteria – Applications will be evaluated taking the following criteria into consideration:
 - Chapter involvement, including attendance at Chapter events and volunteer activity in Chapter initiatives or events
 - Chapter study group involvement (attendance, material contributions, etc.)
 - Length of membership with the IIBA Vancouver Chapter
 - Past board positions
6. Value of Award
 - Approved application and examination fees, paid in Canadian funds.
 - The successful applicant will be required to submit receipts (including exchange rates) for the application and examination fees.
